REGISTRATION TENT

Please come by the registration tent as soon as you arrive, the tent will be located next to the bottom tram platform. You will need to sign a waiver before going up on the tram- note that every single person will need to sign one regardless of what they are doing on the mountain (volunteering, racing, etc).

COME READY TO SKI/BOARD

If possible, please bring your gear with you in case you need to fill in for one of the racers. You can leave your gear in the Timber Room in the chalet.

CHALLENGE CUP TEAMS AND ATHLETES

Each team of 3 will be matched with 1 Athlete with a disability for the race. We will introduce the teams at the Race Briefing, we're asking teams to arrive on time so they get a chance to get to know their athlete.

RACE FORMAT

The race format will be consistency. There will be prizes for closest times (1st, 2nd and 3rd), Top Male time, Top Female time and Best Crash. Prizes will be awarded at the luncheon.

PARKING

You can park anywhere on the Grouse Mountain lots, there will be spaces saved closer to the base. Disabled Parking is located directly in front of the tram entrance in front of the registration tent.

WASHROOMS

Accessible Washrooms are located at the top of the tram outside the Timber Room.
